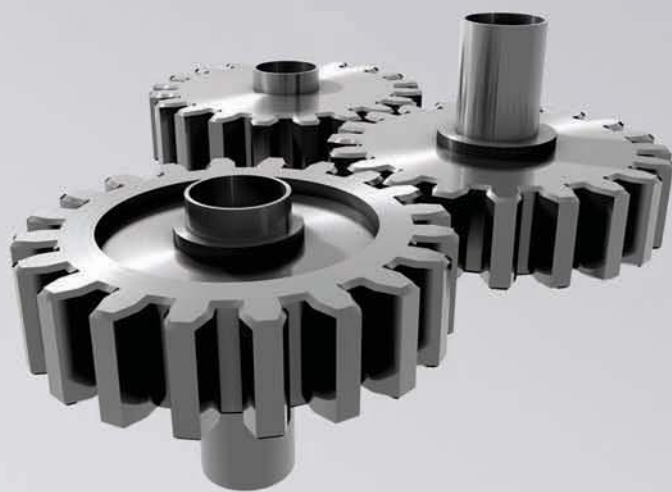

CHEMICAL SERVICES

Chemical Services is the largest speciality chemical group in Southern Africa, supplying a wide range of materials and services across a large area. It is comprised of a number of autonomous subsidiaries and joint ventures, consequently executives spend a great deal of time visiting customers and travelling between various group operations.

CHALLENGE

Because of the way the business is structured, Chemical Services executives were finding it increasingly difficult to stay productive when out of the office. The company looked to provide wireless mobile access to its IBM® Lotus® Domino® architecture.

SOLUTION
